Gayle lives in a condo with the AC on all of the time.
Windows are never opened but have glass windows instead of walls.

Once the flowers drop, she trims the stalk to where the flower first bloomed.
If the stalk dries, then she snips the entire stalk at the bottom.

She waters once a week in the kitchen sink with clean cold water. Then she pours the Miracle Gro water mixture over the roots and leaves and places them back in the ceramic pots to drain wiping the leaves before placing it back onto the tables facing the windows. She said that all the plants would grace them with stalks of blooms each year and this is the only plant that grows in the Ozawa home.

She used to use ice cubes but her plants would infrequently bloom unlike when she does the once a week flushing and Miracle Gro feeding. In the small box Of Miracle Gro there is a spoon with a small and big end. She makes a fresh half gallon pitcher with the Miracle Gro in amount as directed. This is enough for her 4-5 plants. Her oldest plant is about 6 years old.
